## DISCUSSION

### • MOBILE CLINIC

Mobile clinic is a service that Al Jalila Children's is currently working on that aims to provide Dubai residents with "on demand" specialized paediatric healthcare services. Some of the services that the clinic might offer include paediatric primary care for elective cases, immunization, and 'hands on' education for first time parents.

### • PARENT FEEDBACK ON THE MOBILE CLINIC

Parents loved the idea and expressed how it will help them avoid traffic, save time, and manage other children at home. One of the concerns expressed by parents is whether the service will

be covered by insurance. Parents also suggested giving priority in booking appointments as one of the benefits of using the mobile clinic.

Members suggested providing educational sessions for first time mothers where they cover topics such as breastfeeding, milk weaning, and growth monitoring.
